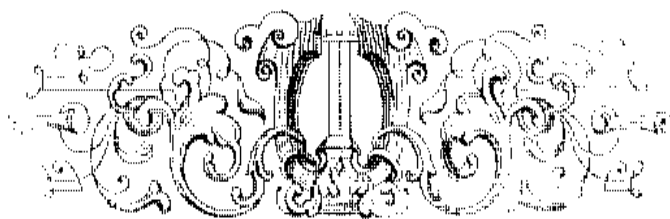

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Foreword

This volume contains two-part settings (high/low voices) of the music for Matins and the First Hour. The melodies are those of the published Anthology of Serbian Chant (2006) volumes featuring Serbian chant with English text. The *Troparia*, *Prokeimena*, Canons etc. are taken from the Sunday matins of the *Oktoechos*. Two penitential hymns from the *Triodion* along with the *Megalyrnarion* of the Nativity of Our Lord have also been included. For navigational purposes, several indices have been interspersed throughout the volume.

Consistent with the recently published Music of Great Vespers (2020) volume, the two-part Matins arrangements maintain a simplified lower voice which is largely that of an *ison* modulating according to the dictates of the chant and featuring frequent cadential elaborations. Although it is notated in the treble clef, this lower part is more suited to a Bass-Baritone voice but could also be sung by an Alto. The upper voice —the chant— can be sung by either a Tenor, Baritone, Mezzo Soprano or a Soprano. Although most of the chants are notated in the key of Fmajor/minor, they can be freely transposed to a suitable register for the singers. Also consistent with the Vespers volume, the Tone 1 settings use the pitch ‘G’ as an *ison* rather than the more typical Serbian practice of harmonizing this Tone in ‘F.’
